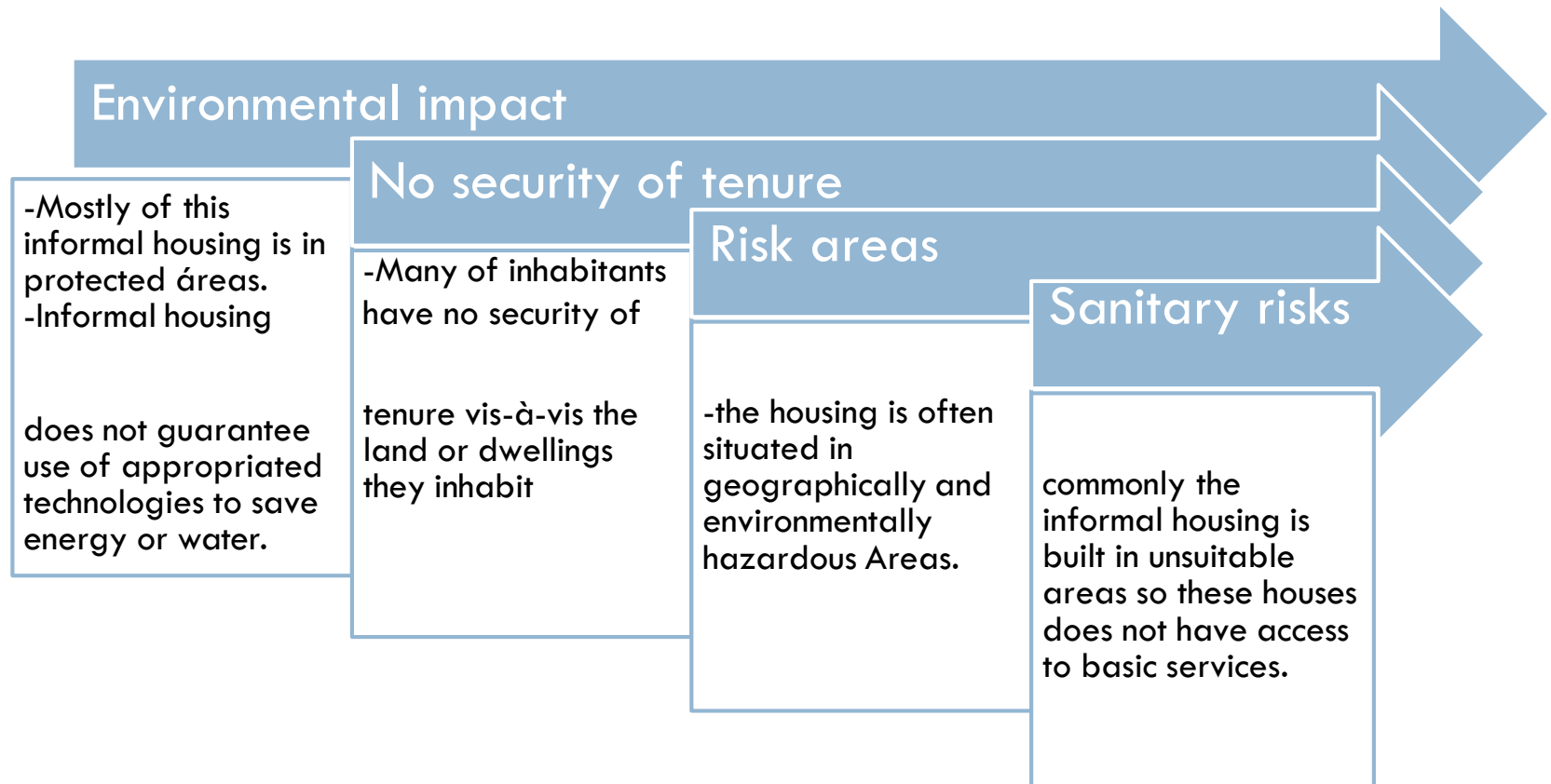

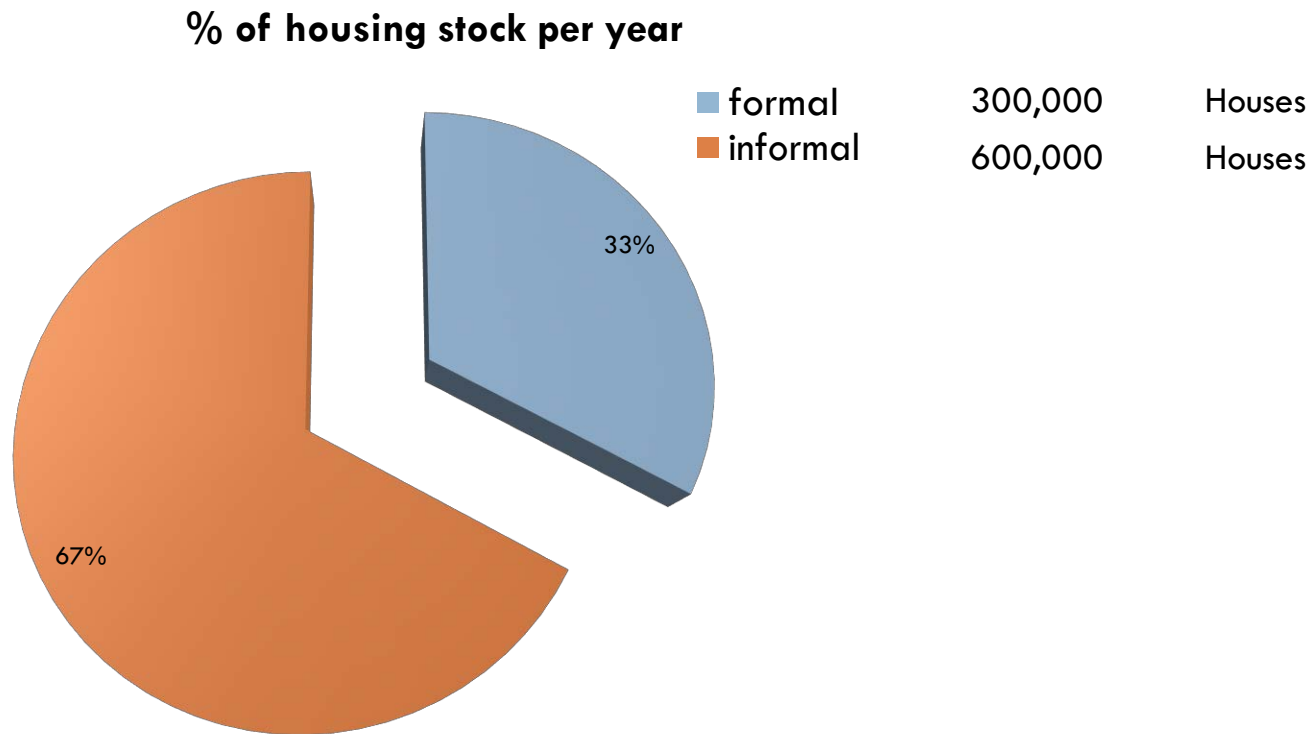

2- What are the challenges that informal housing represent for your country?



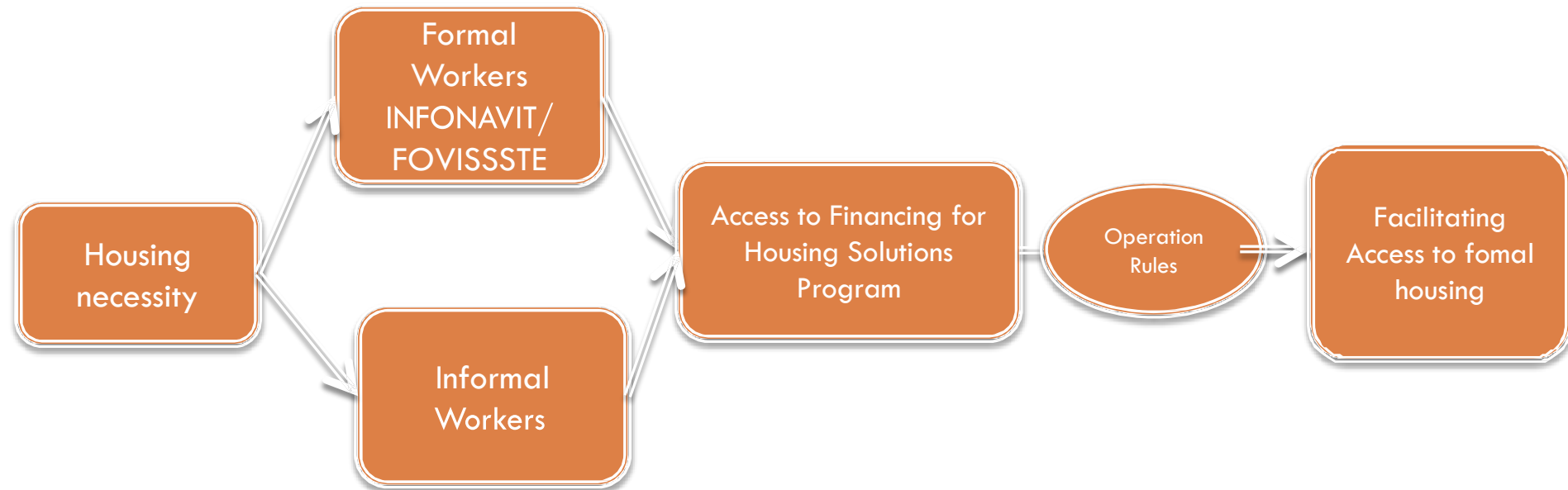
3-What percentage of your housing stock would you consider informal housing?
